



Friends of the Friarage Car Raffle 2019 Terms & Conditions

1. These Terms & Conditions are the Friends of the Friarage Car Raffle 2019 rules. By entering the Car Raffle, all entrants agree to be bound by these rules.
2. The Car Raffle is being promoted by the Friends of the Friarage, a Registered Charity, Number 1160941.
3. For the purposes of the Gambling Act 2005, the Friends of the Friarage Car Raffle 2019 is defined as a 'small society lottery'. As such it is registered with the local authority, namely North Yorkshire County Council.
4. To purchase tickets and enter the Car Raffle, you must be aged 16 years and over and a resident of Great Britain (not Northern Ireland, The Channels Islands or the Isle of Man).
5. Each ticket costs £2. Full payment for each ticket must be received before the ticket can be entered into the draw. Only tickets for which full payment has been received are eligible to win the prize.
6. There will be one winner of a Peugeot car and no cash alternative will be offered.
7. The winner of the Friends of the Friarage Car Raffle 2019 will be notified in person using the contact details provided by the entrant.
8. All entrants are solely responsible for providing their accurate and up to date contact details. The Friends of the Friarage will in no way be liable for any failure or inability to contact any entrant due to errors, omissions or inaccuracies in the contact details that the entrant has provided. It is the responsibility of entrants to inform Friends of the Friarage of any change of name or contact details.
9. The draw will take place at the Barn that Rocks, Grazing Nook Farm, Patrick Brompton, DL8 1LW on **Saturday 1 June 2019**.
10. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to take part in any promotional activity with the Friends of the Friarage and Simon Bailes, Peugeot. These organisations reserve the right to use the name of the winner, their photograph and audio and / or visual recordings of them in any publicity unless prior notification has been received.
11. Friends of the Friarage reserves the right to disqualify any entrant it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these rules.
